Primary - School Fees

Registration Fee: R750.00 payable once-off in January or on admission for all students.

Stationary Fee: R2050.00 per year – payable once off in January or on admission of student.

Grade 0 – 7: R1500.00 per month – Payable in advance for 12 Months. (Boarders and Day Scholars) (Including after school activities)

Primary – Hostel Fees

Registration Fee: R1500.00 payable once-off in January or on admission of all students. Hostel Fee: R3000.00 per month – Payable in advance for 12 Months. (Boarders)

Secondary – School Fees

Registration Fee: R900.00 payable once-off in January or on admission for all students. Stationary Fee: R2700.00 per year – payable once off in January or on admission of student. (Please note that stationary fee includes textbook rental)

Grade 8 - 9: R2500.00 per month – Payable in advance for 12 Months (Boarders and Day Scholars) Grade 10 - 12: R2500.00 per month – Payable in advance for 12 Months (Boarders and Day Scholars)

Secondary – Hostel Fees

Registration Fee: R1500.00 payable once-off in January or on admission of all students. Hostel Fee: R3500.00 per month – Payable in advance for 12 Months. (Boarders Only)

NOTE: North Crest Academy is a full time school starting at 7:45am to 14:00pm Extra mural activities or study is from 14:00 – 16:00pm all students are welcome to stay until 16:00

NOTE: School fees must be paid in advance on or before the 3rd of every month.

NOTE: Textbooks are the property of the school and need to be returned at the end of every school year or on

12.1) School Rules **Applicable to Day Scholars and Boarders**

1) No one is allowed to enter the premises of North Crest Academy under the influence of alcohol or intoxicated with drugs. The school has the right to test any student for drugs or alcohol. Students that are tested positive or are found in possession of the above items will face expulsion with immediate effect. (If found positive of above mentioned, the student will face a 2 week suspension, and expulsion after 3 positive result.)

2) Students are not allowed to smoke or be in possession of cigarettes.

Smoking is prohibited on these premises, for students!

3) No students are to remain in a classroom during break time or lunch time.

4) No eating or drinking is allowed in the classrooms.

5) Students not dressed in proper uniform will not be allowed on the premises.

Hostel students will not be allowed to attend classes if not in full school uniform.

6) No Dreadlocks are allowed. Boy's hair must be kept short and neat at all times (can be cut in any style), beards and moustaches need to be clean shaven. Girls' hair must be tied up/ plaited neatly, no loose hanging hair will be allowed. Highlights (coloured hair) is not allowed. (Black hair only, including on extensions)

7) Miniskirts are not allowed, school skort may only be four fingers above the knees or longer.

8) All stars, pumps and high heels are not allowed! Normal black school shoes only

9) Nail Polish, Acrylic / Gel nails, jewellery and any other form of body rings (e.g. Tongue, eye piercings) are not allowed. Girls may wear small ear studs or rings – 1 / 2 in each ear only! No jewellery or smart watches allowed, it will be confiscated and not returned! 10) Boys are not allowed to wear any earrings or any other piercings.

11) Swinging or riding on chairs, standing and climbing on furniture is not allowed.

12) School starts at 07h45 every day, please make sure your child is on time.

13) School knock-off at 14h00 every day (only for day scholars), no child will be allowed to leave early unless arranged otherwise with school management.

14) You may not litter around and on the school premises. Please make use of the bins provided.

15) Students are not allowed in the office during class hours.

16) If a student is absent he/she should return to school the next day with a letter from the doctor. According to Education dept. rules and regulations, a student may only be absent from school at a limit of 21 days per year, thereafter a student will be expelled 177)nif schoodenttismatightlywith drugs the matter will be reported to the police and he/she will be expelled with immediate effect from the school.

18) No student may enter the school in the possession of weapons of any kind. You will face expulsion with immediate effect. 19) You may not impose harm to any person on these premises. You will face immediate expulsion.

20) Students who do not complete their school tasks & homework will be given misconduct forms. Each students has a limit of 5 misconduct form for minor rule breaking, thereafter a hearing will be held with School management and your parents where your fait will be decided.

21) Any student that imposes harm or damage of any kind to the school property will be held liable for all cost involved in replacing or repairing goods.

22) Students may not remove any furniture out of the classroom, including tables and chairs.

23) Students should carry themselves in an appropriate manner at all times.

24) Stealing and dishonesty is prohibited.

25) It is compulsory for all students to attend assembly every day.

26) Lost or stolen textbooks will be the liability of the student. Textbooks are the property of the school.

27) North Crest Academy will not be held responsible for any lost, stolen & damaged personal items e.g. Money, jewellery.

28) No student will be allowed on the school premises if his/her school & hostel fees are outstanding.

29) Parents may only contact students during break times and after school. Interruptions of classes will not be allowed. Emergencies should be reported to the office.

30) No cell phones are allowed. Students will not get their cell phones back once they have been confiscated. Confiscated cell phones are the property of the school.

31) No day scholar may bring in or supply alcohol, drugs, cigarettes and/or cell phones to hostel students. If you are caught it will result in immediate Expulsion.

32) Respect for management, staff members, teachers & LRC members is very important.

33) Cheating or copying during exams is prohibited!

34) Misconduct and breaking of the school's rules & regulations will lead to disciplinary action and / or expulsion.

35) Please keep the bathrooms and toilets clean at all times.

36) Students that bully other students will receive misconduct forms.

37) An illness of any kind should be reported to the office.

38) In the case of an emergency students will be taken to the hospital.

Parents are responsible for any and all medical costs involved.

39) Students receive their school fees accounts in the form of statements every month-end.

40) Public transport may not enter while playing loud music on this premises. This will result in the transport being banned from the property. School premises should be respected at all times.

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12.2) Hostel Rules Applicable to Hostel Students

1) Boarders are responsible for keeping their own room's clean and tidy at all times

2) Borders will not be allowed to remain in the hostel during school hours unless certified unfit by a doctor not to attend school. The office must know the type of illness, to prevent other students from being infected.

3) It is compulsory for all boarders to attend study sessions.

4) Boarders should dress and carry themselves in an appropriate manner at all times including on weekends. On weekends: during the day you may not wear sleeping garments, make-up or towels.

5) Male students are not allowed in the female's dormitory and female students are not allowed in the male dormitory. If caught you will face expulsion.

6) No students may have sexual intercourse with any other student, male or female on school and hostel premises. If caught you will face expulsion.

7) Statutory rape (student of 16 years and above having sexual relations with a student younger than 16 years - with consent or not) is a serious offence and will be handled as such when you are caught taking part in such an offence. The school will report it to the police and you will be expelled immediately.

8) Students are not allowed to remove any furniture out of the hostel, e.g. Beds, matrass.

9) Lights out by 22h00.

10) No eating and preparing food is allowed in the rooms.

11) Meals will be served in the dining hall. It is compulsory for everyone to be in the dining hall for meals whether you are eating or not.

12) Any student that imposes harm or damage of any kind to the hostel property will be held liable for all cost involved in replacing or repairing goods.

13) Visitor are prohibited to enter the dormitory of the hostel students. Visitors will wait at reception for the student to be called. No males will be allowed in the female dormitory, and no females will be allowed in the male dormitory.14) Boarders may hand over valuables and money to the office for safe keeping.

15) No student is allowed to leave the hostel premises without permission. Students should be signed in and out with the person in charge. Only parents, legal guardians & the selected people (page 1) may sign students in & out

16) North Crest will not be held responsible for any harm, loss, death, etc. That may be imposed upon the student on or off the premises. Students that run away from the hostel at any given time do so at own risk.

17) Inspections and row calls will be conducted at any given time. The school has a right to strip search for anything at any time.

18) Respecting hostel staff and LRC members is very important.

19) You are not allowed to throw away rubbish or anything through and out of the windows. The surroundings of the hostel should be kept clean at all times. Please use the bins provided.

20) No noise or screaming will be allowed on the hostel premises and / or dormitory.

21) Students need to have medication for all common illnesses (e.g. Flu, headache, sinus or hay fever) this will not be supplied by the office

22) Bathing tubs & irons are not allowed.

23) Please wear your own flip flop when showering, do not share shoes at any time, as this could cause fungal infections, and North Crest will not be held responsible.

24) Boys are not allowed to go to the soccer field without permission supervision.

25) Hostel weekend will be allowed every month-end. Parents who do not want their child to come home should fax or email a letter, together with their ID copy and contact details, requesting their children to remain at the hostel with a payment of R280.00. If a student returns on a school day - after school holidays or hostel weekends they must be dressed in school uniform. Students should report back at the hostel after school holidays and hostel weekends on the day before school starts (Sunday) from 10:00am no later than 18:00pm dinner should be supplied by the parent for this day.

Drinking water bottle (for study purposes)
Necessary toiletries and 12 rolls of toilet paper per month.
Your child must have more than three pairs of school uniform (Please ensure that you child has got the right school uniform.
Bucket, Dustbin, Broom, Mop, cloth for cleaning purposes, Bedding

No Cell phones, radios, earphones, or any technological device is allowed, if confiscated it is the property of the school.

Please have your child vaccinated against flu, chicken pox, measles etc.
